The tradition on the grave of Andrew George Scott at Oldfield Cemetery in WOTW - his birth was indicated from his original grave at Rockwood Cemetery (Dorset) (WOTW) & indicated a Challenge Cemetery in January 1892.

### The inscription on the Oldfield grave reads:

Andrew George Scott  
Captain Moonlite  
Born 1842  
Died 20th Jan 1880  
At his interment some rough unhewn rock would be seen, but that skilled hands could have made into something better, it will be the case in months to come and when they shall have shaped it to their own. Andrew George Scott
