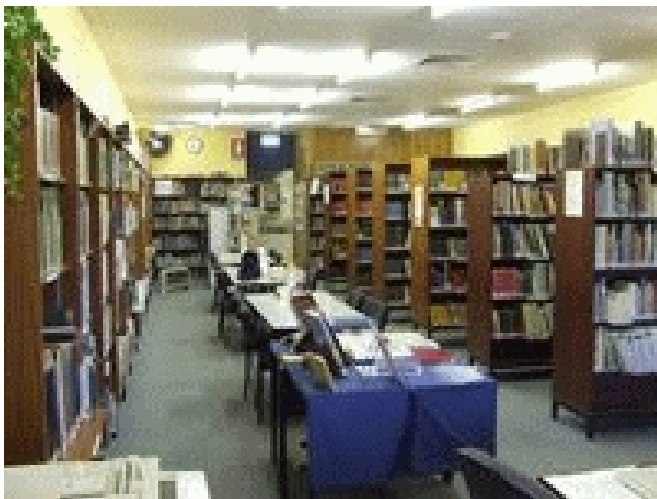

WAGS Microfiche and Microfilm library is also very extensive, and covers all Australian States, New Zealand, Great Britain and Ireland, and European sources, and includes:

WAGS is an affiliated LDS library, which enables full access to the FamilySearch.org database of microfilms, which are being progressively digitised and indexed online.

WAGS eLibrary has over 1400 CD's, with over 2000 searchable items available for members to use in the Library Resource Room. CD copyright owners have been contacted, and where permission has been granted the WAGS EDR (Electronic Document Repository) project team is uploading the CD onto our Library Server. Where permission has not been granted to upload onto our server, the CD will be available to use on a library computer as normal.
