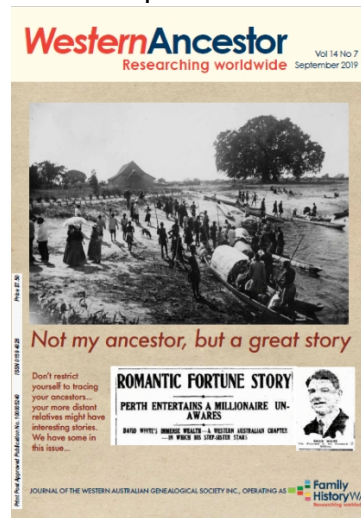


THERE'S lots about DNA in this issue, and our cover depicts Blaine Bettinger and Louise Coakley,
