Bequests

The Society welcomes bequests that can be in the form of: gifts of cash, the whole or percentage of an estate, real estate or stocks and shares. A donor may wish funds to be directed to a specific area or activity of the Society or wish their bequest to be used at the Society's Management Committee's discretion.

The Society recommends that bequest donors seek professional advice in arranging a bequest. Suggested wording for a bequest to the Society can include the following:

I bequeath [the whole/a percentage/something specific/residue] of my estate to the Western Australian Genealogical Society Incorporated for purposes that it shall determine, and this bequest will be free from all duties. The receipt of this bequest by any authorised officer of the Western Australian Genealogical Society Incorporated shall form valid discharge to my executor.
